**Datasection to Hold Press Conference
on Next-Generation AI Platform “TAIZA” on 6 August**

**— From an AI Infrastructure Company to a Core Player in the AI Economy:
A New Strategy to Support Japan’s AI Sovereignty —**

Datasection Inc. (Head Office: Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo; President and Representative Director, Executive Officer and CEO: Norihiko Ishihara; TSE Growth Market: 3905; hereinafter, the “Company”) will hold a press conference on Thursday, 6 August 2026, to present the new strategy for its AI platform, “TAIZA”, together with its future business development plans. The Company, which has grown as an AI infrastructure provider, will introduce “TOKENaaS” (Token as a Service), which it is pursuing as a new growth strategy, as well as “TAIZA MATE”, which serves as the client interface for TOKENaaS and as a new AI partner designed to help users make optimal use of AI.

From “computing resources” to “intelligence resources” in the AI era

As a leading company in the neocloud sector in the Asia-Pacific region, the Company has been developing and operating large-scale GPU clusters.

TAIZA was developed as the underlying technology for these operations: an AI cloud stack that enables the optimal operation of large-scale GPU environments and the integration of multiple AI models.

The AI market is now entering its next stage.

Going forward, what companies, governments and individuals will require is not GPUs themselves, but tokens—the units of intelligence consumed by AI agents. As the use of AI expands across every industry, tokens will become a new form of social infrastructure and serve as a foundation for the AI economy.

From GPUaaS to TOKENaaS

At the press conference, the Company will formally unveil TAIZA MATE as part of TOKENaaS, a new core business that leverages the Company’s GPU clusters.

Under the GPUaaS model, the Company’s principal customers have been cloud service providers (CSPs) and large-scale AI model providers. Under TOKENaaS, however, companies, local governments, government agencies, educational institutions, research institutions and individuals throughout Japan will become direct users.

A society in which everyone who uses AI can access the intelligence they need, whenever they need it.

This is the future that TAIZA seeks to create. This is not merely the launch of a new service, but an initiative to build new social infrastructure that will support Japan’s competitiveness in AI.
