**[Event Report] Datasection Holds Press Conference on Next-Generation AI Platform
“TAIZA” and New AI Service**

Datasection Inc. (Head Office: Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo; President and Representative Director, Executive Officer and CEO: Norihiko Ishihara; Tokyo Stock Exchange Growth Market: 3905; hereinafter the “Company”) held a press conference to introduce its new AI platform, “TAIZA”, and its new service, “TAIZA MATE”.

At the press conference, CEO Ishihara outlined the Company’s strategic shift and the background to the new services. This was followed by a demonstration by Chief Business Officer Scott Trowbridge and a special talk session featuring OpenAI Japan.

Key Highlights of the Press Conference

New Growth Strategy Presented by CEO Ishihara

Democratising Intelligence and Addressing Japan’s Digital Deficit

President and Representative Director, Executive Officer and CEO Norihiko Ishihara opened the session by presenting the Company’s new growth strategy.

“We believe that, in the era ahead, intelligence itself, powered by AI, will become infrastructure supporting business, everyday life, government and society as a whole.”

Building on its strengths in GPU infrastructure, including GPU as a Service, the Company is expanding its business domain into Token as a Service, supporting both the supply and optimal utilisation of AI processing capacity.

TAIZA features smart routing capabilities that automatically select the most appropriate AI model according to the intended use, enabling more efficient inference processing and cost optimisation. By maximising the utilisation of GPU resources, TAIZA provides a new foundation for AI use designed to meet increasingly diverse AI needs.

To address Japan’s growing digital deficit resulting from its reliance on overseas services, the Company is developing GPU data centres while also providing the TAIZA AI platform, thereby building an ecosystem that connects AI infrastructure, AI models and applications.

Through this initiative, the Company aims to support a broad range of AI use cases across businesses, research institutions, government bodies and individuals, and to contribute to the development and enhanced competitiveness of Japan’s AI industry.



Announcement of the Next-Generation AI Platform “TAIZA” and “TAIZA MATE”

Scott Trowbridge provided a demonstration and introduction to the new services.

TAIZA is an enterprise platform that centrally manages the development, operation and governance of AI solutions. Administrators can manage AI models, GPU utilisation, costs and governance in an integrated manner, while also enabling safe and efficient AI operations through workflow design, the use of multiple AI models, human review and integration with organisational data.

TAIZA MATE is not simply a chat tool, but a workspace designed to enable AI to perform actual business tasks. Simply by giving instructions in natural language, users can have AI structure tasks, manage progress and help produce deliverables.

It also enables multiple types of work, including market research, planning and creative production, to be carried out consistently while sharing context on a project-by-project basis. By making the execution process, AI models used and resulting outputs visible, TAIZA MATE provides a high degree of traceability and governance.



Special Talk Session with OpenAI Japan

The Company welcomed Masami Mizukoshi, Technical Success Lead at OpenAI Japan, for a special discussion.

AI implementation among Japanese companies has reached a critical stage, with the potential to play an important role in driving future economic growth.

The discussion covered a range of themes, including the importance of data governance and the provision of domestic infrastructure that companies can use with confidence; maximising user experience through the use of OpenAI APIs; the new experiences enabled by voice AI and its potential for real-world deployment; and the global expansion of AI agents originating in Japan.

The session highlighted growing expectations for the next phase of AI implementation.
